## Trip to RIBA (Royal Institute of British Architects)

On Monday 25<sup>th</sup> March, the Junior Art Club & Eco Club visited the Royal Institute of British Architects at 66 Portland Place. This trip brought to life the projects that both clubs have been working on this term with Sabrina, our art club tutor, and gave the children an insight into designing and building for the world and climate we live in, as well as how Architects build to "Make the Future a Better Place" – RIBA.



This Term the Junior Art Club children have taken a particular interest in building structures through the weekly 'Creation Station Table' that runs alongside a more focused art activity. The children have been using an abundance of useful items recently collected from the Children's Scrap project. Imagination has been free flow; a box of wooden sticks being such a hit! They were used to create houses, football goals, rafts and lots of other ideas in-between. Ending the term with a collaborative effort to make a theatre, characters and some script writing for fun.





At RIBA, 'Sustainable Building' has a real spotlight and Eco Club's whole ethos is based on Eco-friendly living so combining the trip for both clubs, on this occasion, was a real success. The RIBA workshop leader was very impressed with how knowledgeable our children were and called them budding experts as they were able to confidently answer all workshop questions. They could also name sustainable materials as well as present their own ideas for eco-friendly designs.
