### Intra-class competitions 2019-20

Year 3-6 have started this years intra class competitions this year with dodgeball. The competitions take place on Thursday's from 12.30-1pm. The aim is for all pupils to take part in an effort to maximise their team sores which go towards winning the shield for their class. Teams all start on 200 points but lose 10 points for any player who does not turn up to compete and can also gain points for excellent behaviour/honesty or lose points for poor behaviour/dishonesty! They also gain 30 points if they win, 20 points for second place and 10 points for 3rd place. The competitions last for 2 weeks for each year group with a maximum score of 260 points possible before bonus points are added.
