

Happy New Year! We hope you had an enjoyable holiday period.

### World Book Day

World Book Day will be celebrated this year on Thursday 2<sup>nd</sup> March, and we are planning a production for Y5 to perform to parents that morning. Timings will be confirmed closer to the time. Your child will have a role in the production and we appreciate your support helping them learn their lines.

### Learning

In **English** we are reading: The Ice Trap (by Meredith Hooper) and Cosmic (by Frank Cottrell Boyce) as well as exploring newspapers and how to write a news article. In **Maths** we will be having a focus on decimals. Our **Science** topic is 'Space' during which we will learn about the solar system, space exploration and forces.



This term years 2 to 6 will all be teaching a geography unit. We have redesigned our geography curriculum this year, and we will soon be able to share with you the new "Knowledge Organiser" for our unit of learning. You can read more about this in the WHPS Weekly published on 24<sup>th</sup> January. Year 5's unit is **Climate Zones**, and will involve learning about the Arctic circle, the Tropics, and a range of places from different climate zones (Heraklion, Kismayo, Tromsø, Dhaka and Rockhampton).
