


# 1 Our Secret Garden

**Geography**

**Near**  
Something close-by.

**Far**  
Something that is not close.

**Left / right**  
Words which help to describe where something is.

**Season**  
The weather over the year, divided into four parts.

**City**  
Bigger than a town with some important buildings.

**Town**  
More houses and buildings than a village.

**Village**  
A group of houses and buildings in the countryside.

**Factory**  
A building where things are made, mostly by machines.

**Farm**  
A piece of land where food is grown and animals live.

**House**  
A building where people live.

**Office**  
A place where people work.

**Shop**  
A building which sells things.
